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Qualification Overview

The Ascentis Entry 3 Award in Equality and Diversity is a short one-unit qualification that introduces the learner to the key terms in relation to equality and diversity.

There are several features of this qualification that make it very appropriate for its target learners:

- Assessment and certification can be offered throughout the year, allowing maximum flexibility for centres
- It can be delivered either as a classroom-based course or as a blended learning programme
- Assessment is by a multiple-choice test, offered on screen or on paper. This will normally be taken at the end of the course
- There are online resources that can be used alongside the teaching

Aims

The aims of the qualification are to enable learners to:

- 1 Understand the meaning of equality and diversity
- 2 Understanding the meaning of discrimination and prejudice
- 3 Understand how organisations can promote best practice in relation to equality and diversity

Target Group

The qualification is aimed at a range of learners, including:

- Young people wishing to pick up an Award as part of another learning programme
- Young people aged 14–19 who are in various learning environments

Assessment Method

This qualification is assessed through the completion of an Ascentis-devised multiple-choice test that is carried out at the completion of the course. It is available as a paper-based test or e-assessment.

Learners must complete one unit for the Ascentis Entry 3 Award in Equality and Diversity. This is a singleunit qualification and certification is given for achieving a pass in the external assessment.
