

Qualification Overview

The Ascentis Level 1 Award in Preventing Plastic Pollution gives learners an understanding of different types of plastics and their uses, as well as how to reduce pollution. The topic of plastic pollution has been well covered in the media and this qualification aims to help learners understand the subject and its impacts.

There are several features of this qualification that make it very appropriate for its target learners:

- Assessment and certification can be offered throughout the year, allowing maximum flexibility for centres
- Can be delivered either as a classroom-based course or as a blended learning programme
- Assessment is by a multiple-choice test, offered on screen or on paper. This will normally be taken at the end of the course
- There are online resources that can be used alongside the teaching

Aims

The aims of the qualification are to enable learners to understand:

- Different types of plastics and their uses
- How to dispose of plastics
- How plastics affect marine environments
- How plastics pollution can be reduced

Target Group

The qualification is aimed at a range of learners, including:

- Young people wishing to pick up an Award as part of another learning programme
- Young people aged 14 19 who are in various learning environments
- Adult learners
