Qualification Overview

The Ascentis Maintaining a Wheeled Vehicle qualifications are designed to deepen a learner's knowledge about vehicle care and maintenance, enable them to carry out vehicle care and maintenance checks, obtain specialist advice when appropriate and know the main controls of a vehicle.

There are several features of these qualifications that make them very appropriate for their target learners:

- Unit certification is available for each of the units
- Verification and certification can be offered throughout the year, allowing maximum flexibility for centres
- They can be delivered either as classroom-based courses or as a blended learning programme
- Evidence can be generated within a wide range of organisational contexts, allowing the qualification to meet the specific occupational requirements of the learners

Aims

The aims of the qualifications are to enable learners:

- 1 To know about vehicle care and maintenance, including carrying out vehicle care and maintenance checks
- 2 To know how to obtain specialist advice when appropriate and know the main controls of a vehicle
- 3 To develop a broad range of skills in vehicle and bicycle maintenance and care

Target Group

These qualifications are aimed at a range of learners who are either interested in developing their skills in maintaining a wheeled vehicle for personal use and/or planning further study or employment in vehicle maintenance.

Assessment Method

All units are internally assessed through the learner building up a portfolio of evidence that covers the relevant assessment criteria, internally assessed and verified by the centre and then externally verified by Ascentis.

On completion of the learners' evidence for either the individual units or the Award or Certificate, the assessor is required to complete the Summary Record of Achievement for each learner. The Summary Record of Achievement asks assessors and the internal verifier to confirm that the rules of combination have been followed. This is particularly important in cases where a learner has taken units at different levels. The Summary Record of Achievement form is provided in Appendix 1.

Centres are required to retain all evidence from all learners for external verification and for four weeks afterwards in case any appeal is made.

Rule of Combination

Ascentis Level 1 Award and Certificate in Maintaining a Wheeled Vehicle				
Learners must achieve 7 credits in total to achieve the Award and 21 credits in total to achieve the Certificate. Learners must achieve the Mandatory unit and the remaining credits can be taken from Group B. 51% of the units must be taken at Level 1.
