Construction Qualifications

Centres must ensure that Construction qualifications are delivered in a safe and Covid-secure way, following internal procedures.

- Tools should not be shared/handled by multiple users. Where possible sanitise tools before someone else handles them
- Workstations/workbenches should be sanitised after use
